



Reverse Auction Terms & Conditions



Terms & Conditions of money awarded by Dartmoor National Park Authority (DNPA) funded by the Environment Agency.

General

1. All works carried out by the Applicant will conform to the details submitted in the application (location, specifications, timescale)
2. All works will be carried out in accordance with the advice that has been received.
3. It is the Applicant's duty to ensure that the construction works are designed and carried out with due regard to the health and safety of all operatives. The HSE website www.HSE.gov.uk has further information and relevant information sheets on health and safety issues on the Construction (design and management) Regulations 2015.
4. The Applicant will take ownership of the capital works and take full responsibility and liability.
5. The Applicant will only use the money for the purpose as outlined in the original application. The purposes of all funding is 'flood risk reduction' and 'slowing the flow'.
6. The Applicant is responsible for maintaining any capital works. Maintaining a structure is defined as:
 - Ensuring the structure's functioning ('flood risk reduction' and 'slowing the flow')
 - Ensuring the structure is not causing any of the following issues:
 - × Blockages of nearby culverts and bridges
 - × Flooding of nearby highways or roads
 - × Erosion issues, for example undercutting river banks
 - × Health and safety issues on rights of way
7. The Applicant acknowledges that a representative of DNPA or the Environment Agency may conduct a site visit to inspect the construction or maintenance of any structure paid for by this funding.

Payment

8. Payment will be made in accordance with the estimates submitted with the application, once the work is completed to a satisfactory standard.
9. The Applicant acknowledges that the payments will not be increased if the capital works exceed the original quotes that were submitted with this application.

10. If the Applicant is VAT registered, payments will be paid exclusive of VAT. If the applicant is not VAT registered, all payments can include the cost of VAT.

11. Payment will be made within 30 working days of inspection and/or receipt of photographs and receipts of completed works.

Grant from other Public Bodies

12. The offer is made on the understanding that, when making the application, the Applicant disclosed any financial contributions which may be received for the same purpose from any other body.

Breach of Conditions

13. The Applicant accepts that DNPA may demand repayment of all or part of the funding if the Applicant fails to meet any of the conditions above.
